Position Summary

LSCSS is seeking a dedicated and experienced Permanent Part-Time Cook to join our team. This role provides consistent scheduling with a 4-days-on, 2-days-off rotation (average of 36 hours per week). The Cook plays a vital role in ensuring the provision of nutritious meals in a supportive housing environment while maintaining food safety standards and a clean, organized kitchen.

Key Responsibilities

- Prepare and serve meals and snacks in accordance with established menus and dietary requirements.
- Follow food safety protocols, monitor inventory, and ensure proper food storage.
- Maintain a clean and organized kitchen, including dishwashing and sanitization.
- Assist with meal planning and menu modifications as needed.
- Report equipment malfunctions and safety concerns to the Housing Coordinator.
