Lower Similkameen Community Services Society (LSCSS) is seeking a Casual Counsellor to support the delivery and development of the Men+ Healthy Relationships Counselling Program, a developing pilot initiative responding to service gaps related to intimate partner violence (IPV), gender-based violence, and healthy relationships in rural communities.

This position provides casual counselling support to men and non-binary adults (19+), including individuals who have experienced violence and those who are concerned about their use of harmful behaviours and are seeking change. In addition to direct counselling, this role will contribute to the ongoing development and refinement of the Men+ counselling framework during the pilot phase.

Location: Based in Keremeos, BC, supporting surrounding communities of Cawston, Hedley and Olalla
Hours: Casual hours scheduled as needed, based on client demand and funding availability

- Provide individual counselling aligned with STV and PEACE principles, prioritizing the safety of survivors, children, and others
- Deliver counselling within clearly defined service streams (survivor support and accountability & change)
- Conduct intake screening, risk assessment, safety planning, and referrals
- Contribute to program development, evaluation, and learning during the pilot phase
- Maintain appropriate clinical documentation and participate in supervision and case consultation
- Work collaboratively with internal programs and external referral partners as appropriate
