Join Lower Similkameen Community Services Society (LSCSS) as a Casual Cook. We are looking for reliable casual staff to support food service at our housing programs by preparing and serving nutritious meals and helping maintain a clean, safe, and welcoming kitchen environment.

Wage: \$27.33/hour + 4% vacation pay

Hours: Casual/on-call hours; shifts are offered as they become available

Schedule: Casual Cooks may pick up shifts as available for sick leave, vacation coverage, weekends, holidays, and other operational needs.

Position Overview: The Casual Cook is an important part of the LSCSS team, supporting tenants through friendly, reliable food services that contribute to comfort, independence, and quality of life.

Casual Cooks prepare and serve meals and snacks in accordance with established menus and dietary requirements, follow food safety protocols, monitor inventory, ensure proper food storage, and maintain a clean and organized kitchen.

Casual shifts may be available to provide sick leave, vacation, weekend, holiday, or other coverage for housing food service operations.

Other related duties may be assigned.
